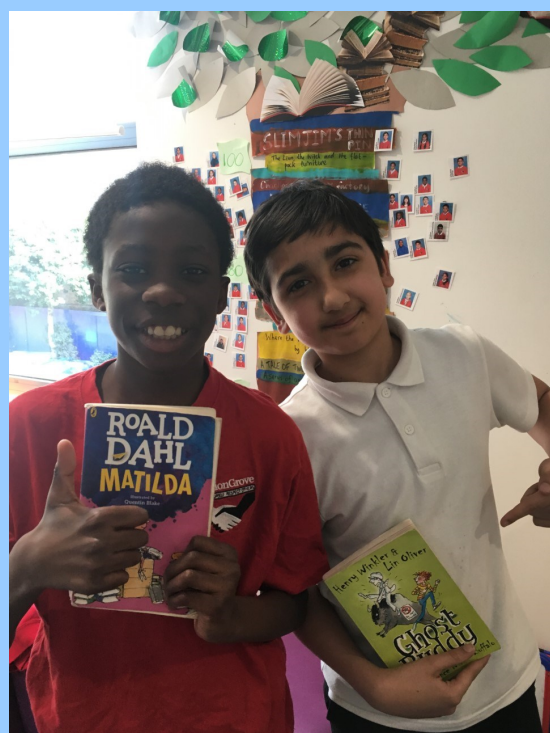

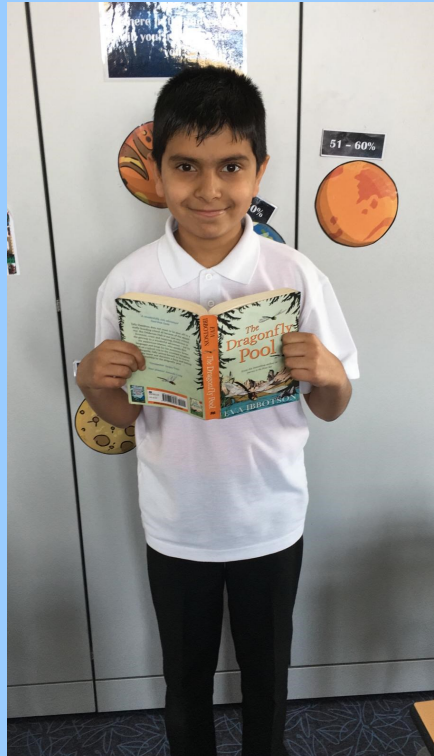

We will be walking between the 2 sites next Friday morning to share with the local community our Easter bonnets. There will be prizes for the most original and creative hats/masks.



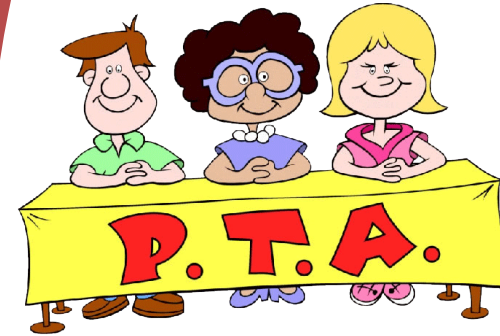
