## Mission Grove App

We are aware that lots of parents have been having problems with the school app. We have been working with the company that makes the app to solve the problem.

We now a have a solution – but we need to you download a slightly different version of the app, then delete the old app. This should solve any problems you have been having. Miss Kent has been trialling the new app this week and it is much faster and more reliable than the old version, with further updates coming soon.

Please follow these steps to download the new app:

- 1. Go to the app store (apple or android) and search for 'Piota Schools'
- 2. Download this app. Then type 'Mission Grove' into the white box. Select 'Mission Grove Primary' from the dropdown list.
- 3. You will then be asked if you want to receive push notifications. Please click 'Set up now', then click 'Allow'. This means you will receive alerts from us. Once you have done this the app should look exactly the same as it did before.
- 4. To make sure you are getting the correct alerts, please click 'more' then 'settings', then 'channels'. Select the classes your children are in. Please keep 'urgent notices' selected. PLEASE DON'T SKIP THIS STEP! It means you get the correct alerts and we don't bombard you with things that aren't relevant to you.
- 5. Once this is done, please delete the old app.

When you want to use the app, press the 'Piota Schools' icon on your phone and you will go directly to the Mission Grove app. Any alert from 'Piota Schools' will be from us at Mission Grove.

Free school meals now have amended regulations to implement a net earnings threshold of £7,400 to come into force from 1 April 2018.
