

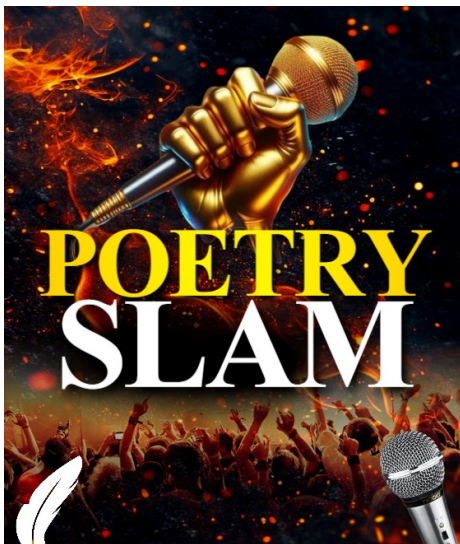


Thank you for your on going support. We had lots of parents in and around school this week from parent volunteers on trips to Reception stay and play and

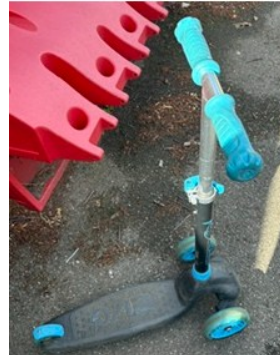
So we have finished another half term and just have 7 weeks left of this academic year!
