We met on Tuesday to talk about up and coming fundraising events for the school.

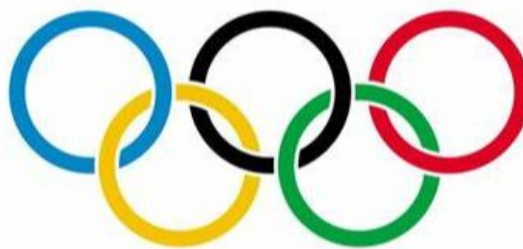
June 12th to celebrate the start of the World Football Cup, we will be having a non- uniform day and asking for a donation of £1.

Selected pupils from Year 5 and Year 6 recently took part in the exciting Tour de Waltham Forest cycling event, joining schools from across the borough to celebrate active travel, cycling skills, and friendly competition.

Throughout the day, the children rotated through a series of carefully designed cycling activities that tested balance, control, awareness, and teamwork. They practiced essential cycling safety skills, including maneuvering around obstacle courses, signaling correctly, and navigating shared spaces responsibly. 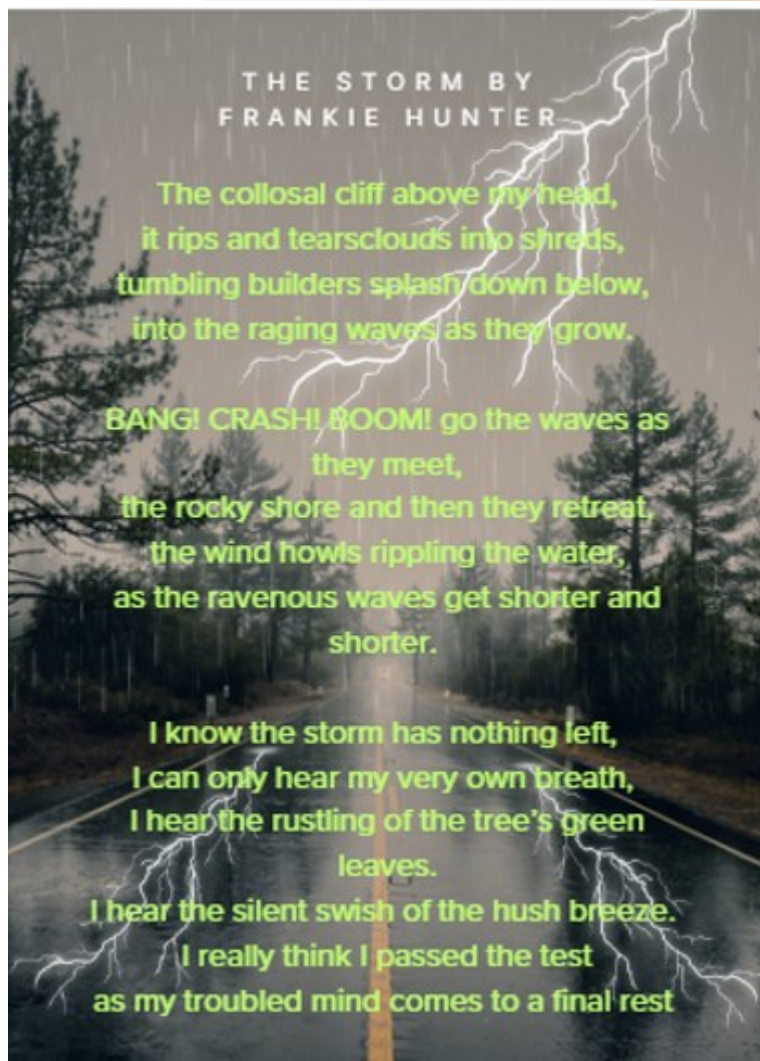

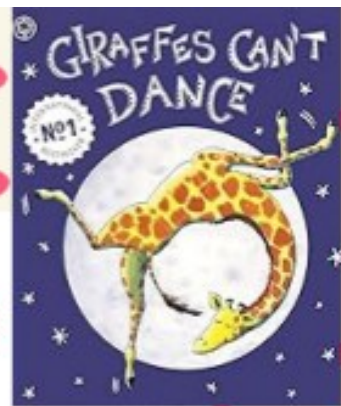
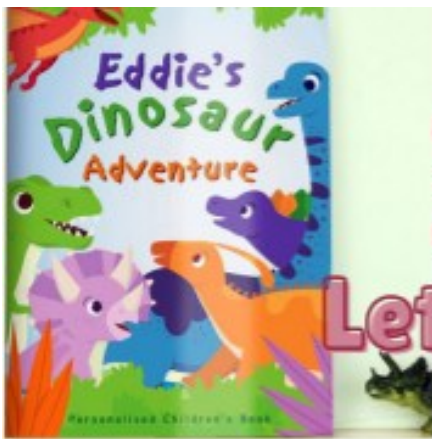
