



Sports Coach - Job Description

Duties

- Carry out all school policies and adhere to expectations of conduct outlined in the Staff Handbook.
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum in the subject area in line with statutory guidance and school policies.
- Maintain discipline among the pupils, safeguarding their health and safety on the school premises and when they are engaged in school activities elsewhere.
- Deliver stimulating and effective lessons, differentiated to meet the needs of all pupils including the most able.
- Carry out effective formative and summative assessment procedures in line with school policy.
- Consult and communicate with parents and agencies outside the school and provide written reports as required.

Professional Development

- Participate in arrangements for the management of performance.
- Review and refine methods of teaching and delivery of the curriculum area to ensure standards are consistently high across the school.
- Attend appropriate courses for professional development and participate in school-based training.

Curriculum and National Support School Duties

- Provide exemplary lessons, including planning and assessment for visiting teachers and leaders.
- Maintain an exemplary teaching and learning environment to act as a model for others.
- Responsible for resources ensuring stored within an appropriate storage area, ensuring all resources are well maintained
- Maintain exemplary attitudes to learning through stimulating teaching where independence, determination and resilience are in constant evidence.
- Creating a love for sport within all students and an understanding of competitiveness.
- Working with individual children or teams, depending on the sport, ensuring each child reaches their full potential in their chosen area
- Planning programmes of training for up coming events, combing practice and discussions of good play
- Attending competitions
- Inspiring confidence and self belief in all children
- Developing knowledge and understanding of fitness, injury, nutrition and sports science
