ACCESSIBILITY PLAN

Introduction

The Governing Body at Mission Grove Primary School recognises the following duties that this places upon them:

- Not to treat disabled pupils less favourably for a reason related to their disability
- To make reasonable adjustments for disabled pupils, so that they are not at a substantial disadvantage
- To plan to make reasonable adjustments to the school buildings so that there is an increased access to education for disabled pupils and to make the school building more accessible for disabled persons

The Governing Body have responsibility to:

- Increase the extent to which disabled pupils can participate in the school curriculum
- Improve the physical environment of the school to enable disabled pupils to take better advantage of education and associated services
- Improve the delivery to disabled pupils of information which is provided in writing for pupils who are not disabled

Schools are required to resource, implement and review their Accessibility Plan as necessary.

This plan will be monitored by the Governing Body. The plan attached sets out the school's proposals for increasing access to education for disabled pupils.

Disability and Mission Grove Primary School

The definition of disability under the law is a wide one. A disabled person is someone who has a physical or mental impairment that has an adverse, substantial and long term effect on their ability to carry out normal day to day activities.

Mission Grove Primary School wants to ensure that there is no discrimination against any sub-group within its community, be it because of gender, religion, race or disability. With this in mind the school has put in place policies and procedures so that disabled people are not treated less favourably in the service, education or support they receive than people without a disability. Meeting these requirements is consistent with the school's Inclusion Policy.

This plan will be shared with the Senior Leadership Team and will inform relevant aspects of the school's development plan.
