Your child takes a Star
Reading test at the
beginning of the year to
determine their reading
level.

This is completed
independently on a
computer. Questions adjust
according to the answers
your child gives.

If they are correct then the
difficulty increases.
If they can't answer it, the
difficulty reduces.

The test uses multiple
choice questions and takes
approximately 20 minutes
to complete.

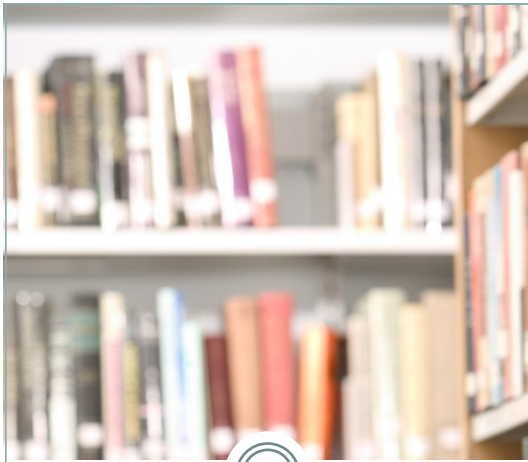

Accelerated Reading

AR is a computer program that helps teachers to monitor the progress of your child's reading.

A child picks a levelled book to read at their own pace. They read every morning in class. When finished they complete a short quiz on the iPad.

Passing the quiz is an indication that they have understood what they have read.

QUIZZES

After reading a book the children will complete a quiz in school related to the book.

If they get 80% or more of the answers correct they earn points.

We will be rewarding children with certificates and prizes for their points.

We will also be keeping an eye on how many words they read. There will be a millionaire club for the children who have read a millionaire words.



ZPD

Zone of Proximal Development—ZPD, is the range of books that will challenge a child without causing frustration or loss of motivation.

Children will chose a book within their ZPD zone, for example : 2.3 to 3.3

2.3 will be the easier books for your child and 3.3 will be more challenging. It is fine for the children to read any books within the range as they will stay at the level until they are tested again.

Please don't worry if one day they pick a lower level then the day before , they are all appropriate for your child's needs.
