Ask a parent, grandparent, or family friend about what life was like when they were 9 or 10. Write a comparison between their childhood and yours.

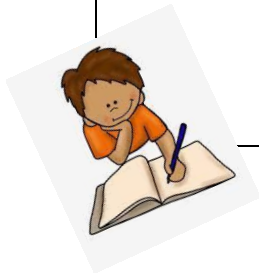


Write a letter to your new teacher.
