Reception

There are three classes in this open plan setting. Here you will spend lots of time with your friends and teachers, learning and playing together.



In each class, there is a Maths table, Literacy table, Art table, Construction table and a Small World table which all link to your current class topic.

Challenge: Can you talk about your favourite activity to do at home?



There is a home corner as well as a role play corner linking to our topic every half term. Each class also has a dedicated quiet reading corner.



You will have your own coat peg labelled with your name, and a tray to put your book bag in.

Challenge: Can you spot your name on your peg and your tray independently?



This is the carpet area in your classroom where you will sit with your friends to do some fun learning activities! Here, you have a interactive C-Touch screen for all your interactive learning experiences.

Challenge: Practice sitting with your legs crossed, and with your hands on your lap. Can you stand up and sit down without holding on to someone?



There are two universal toilets within each reception classroom. There is a soap dispenser, a mirror and hand dryer for good practice of hygiene.

Challenge: Can you go to the toilet on your own? Can you flush the toilet and wash your hands by yourself?

Playground



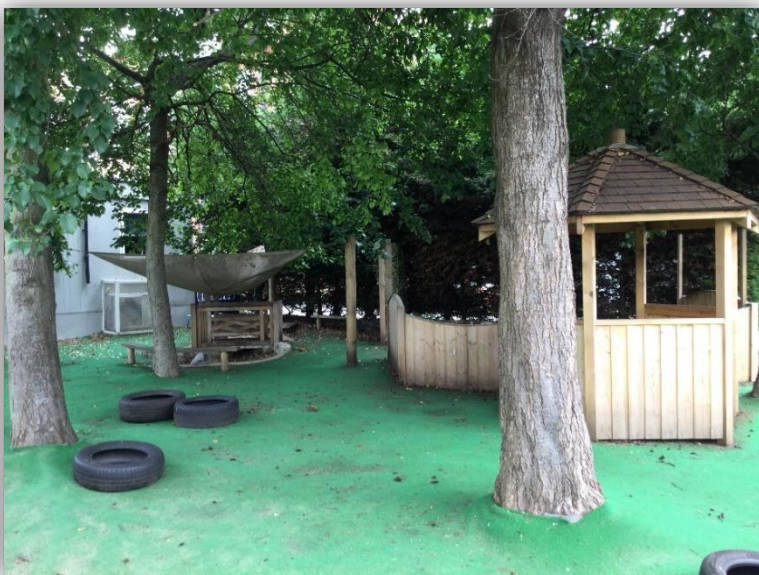
There are three sections to the Reception playground.

This is the climbing area which includes climbing frame, a climbing wall, balance beams and a bridge.

Challenge: Can you balance across a balance beam and jump off safely?



This area has a large climbing frame where various activities are set up. You can zip down the fireman's pole, or come down the slide. There is also a large sand pit.



In this section, there is a hut with seating, a bridge, tyres and large construction for free play as well as bikes and scooters. You can also cook your own food in the mud kitchen!

Lunch time



The canteen is right next to the classrooms. There is always a lovely selection of food to choose from, as well as fresh salad and bread every day. The chef will ask you what you would like to eat, and you will need to tell them in a loud and clear voice.

Challenge: Can you make a choice between two different foods? Can you choose your salad?



Once you have collected your lunch from the canteen, you will eat your lunch in the dining hall with all your friends and sometimes with your teachers too!

Challenge: Can you carry your plate of food to the table? When finished eating, can you clear your plate of food and stack your plate up?

When not being used for lunch, we also use this hall for assemblies and PE lessons.



Farm

Our school has a farm. Here, you will find rabbits, guinea pigs, ducks and chickens. You can come out to the farm to feed the animals and collect eggs.

Challenge: How many animals can you spot in this picture?



Library Bus

We visit the library once a week to choose two books to take home to read. We also visit the library just to relax and read on the comfortable sofas!

Challenge: Can you turn the pages of a book independently?



Sensory Room

Our sensory room allows pupils the freedom and autonomy to explore the environment for themselves, in their own time, using all of their senses.



Wildlife Garden

Here, you will find a pond with plenty of frogs, a Biodome with homegrown vegetables, a Bird Hide for bird watching and a bug hotel. There's even a lovely tree at the back which we can climb on!
