





Year 5, Half Term Project - Spring 2

<p>Create a map of Walthamstow Draw or print a map of Walthamstow and label key human and physical features (e.g. parks, schools, shops, transport).</p> 	<p>Photo Walk Take 5–10 photos of interesting places in Walthamstow. Add captions explaining why they are important.</p>	<p>My Street Fact File Create a non-fiction fact file about your street or local area. Include headings, facts and a map or photo.</p> 
<p>Local Landmark Research Research a famous Walthamstow landmark (e.g. Walthamstow Market, Lloyd Park, Vestry House). Create a poster.</p>	<p>William Morris Pattern Design Design your own repeating pattern inspired by William Morris. Use natural shapes, plants or animals.</p> 	<p>Walthamstow News Report Write a non-fiction news report about a real or made-up event in Walthamstow. Use formal language and headings.</p>
<p>A Tourist Guide to Walthamstow Create a leaflet or brochure encouraging people to visit Walthamstow. Include attractions, transport and history.</p> 	<p>Nature in Our Areas Go for a walk and record plants, trees or wildlife you see. Present as a mini nature guide.</p>	<p>Interview a Local Person Interview someone who lives or works in Walthamstow. Write up their answers as a non-fiction report.</p>
